Setting the scene

In October 2022, Insights HQ (trading as Camorra Research) were commissioned to undertake an independent, robust, and representative analysis of sentiment towards commercial greyhound racing among the New Zealand population.

The objective of the research was to provide unbiased and reliable data regarding:

- Current awareness and familiarity with commercial greyhound racing
- Current attitudes and perceptions
- Level of current support or opposition
- Context, in terms of current relevant behaviours



Research Sample

Inisghts HQ were commissioned to conduct a second wave in 2024 to understand if attitudes towards commercial greyhound racing have changed.

In both waves, it was crucial to optimise data integrity through sampling and research design metholdologies.

In 2022, we surveyed a base of 1,327.

In 2024, a base of 817 were surveyed.

The my2cents sampling solution was employed, which allows validation of results and is the preferred sampling source for all major NZ banks.

To ensure representativeness, we employed a multicell quota design with interlocking quotas for age, gender, and region. Final data was weighted to NZ Census data.

The questionnaire was designed using balanced response scales.



Notes on methodology

Insights HQ are sampling and data experts within the market research industry. We provide syndicated sample and research for the NZ finance industry, including all major banks via our syndicated sample solution my2cents.

We also work with Waka Kotahi NZTA and the Commerce Commission to provide robust and representative research among the New Zealand population.

For this research, New Zealanders were invited by email in November 2024 to complete the survey. The invite did not mention SPCA, nor did the questionnaire, in order to maintain research independence.

Respondents were invited to click a link in the email, which took them to the survey platform (my2cents) where they completed the 8-10 minute questionnaire.

To ensure data integrity, the sample was representative, robust, and reflective:

- Representative: we use interlocking quota design so that the final sample is nationally representative by age, gender, and region
- Robust: we interviewed a large sample of 817
- Reflective: we avoid long, interrogation style questionnaires which encourage speeding and damage data integrity
- Questionnaire design includes balanced scales, options for respondents to say, "don't know" (i.e. we don't force or lead responses)

Data was analysed and the following top-line report produced. We focus on providing a comprehensive, objective, and evidence-led report. Transparency is important to Insights HQ, and so we welcome questions.




MARKET CONTEXT Current awareness and participation

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Over two thirds are either unaware (13%) or are aware but don't know anything about commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand (50%).

This has remained largely unchanged over the last 2 years.

FAMILIARITY WITH COMMERCIAL GREYHOUND RACING




Q. How familiar are you with commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand? Base Total 2022 n=1,327, 2024 n=817

The majority (53%) have not heard anything about commercial greyhound racing recently.

Among those who have, this is most likely to be via a news or current affairs TV show.

RECENTLY HEARD ANYTHING ABOUT COMMERCIAL GREYHOUND RACING




Q. Have you recently heard or read anything about commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand? If so, where? Base Total n=817

Over 65s are more likely to have heard something recently about commercial greyhound racing, particularly from news / current affairs shows or via friends / family.

Among younger New Zealanders who have recently heard something, online and radio are more common sources.

RECENTLY HEARD ANYTHING ABOUT COMMERCIAL GREYHOUND RACING




Q. Have you recently heard or read anything about commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand? If so, where? Base Total n=817


The large majority of New Zealanders are unlikely to either attend or bet on a greyhound race in the next 6 months.

Approximately 4% of the population are likely to attend or gamble on commercial greyhound racing in the next 6 months, indicating the financial benefits of commercial greyhound racing to the local economy are minor.



SUPPORT CONTINUATION OF COMMERCIAL GREYHOUND RACING

Only 1 in 10 New Zealanders support the continuation of commercial greyhound racing.

Over half (58%) opposes its continuation.



Q. Do you support the continuation of commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand? Base 2024 n=817




GENERAL VIEW ON COMMERCIAL GREYHOUND RACING

On balance, most New Zealanders think there are more negatives than positives to commercial greyhound racing.

About a quarter think the positive and negative aspects are probably balanced, while 72% think there are more negative aspects.

This has remained unchanged over the past 2 years and we infer it is unlikely to change in the near future.



Q. Some people think there are positives to commercial greyhound racing while others think there are negatives. On balance, do you think there are more positive or negative aspects?



When asked about positive aspects of commercial racing, the most cited reasons are financial.

- 34% believe greyhound racing creates jobs and financial opportunity
- 23% believe greyhound racing contributes to the economy

However, 42% don't believe there are any positive aspects of commercial greyhound racing.

When asked about negative aspects of commercial racing, the common


Promotion of gambling

themes revolve around the:

- Normalising the exploitation of animals
- Greyhound health and welfare
- Euthanasia of greyhounds

In total, almost all New Zealanders (94%) recognise that there are negative impacts of commercial greyhound racing.

PERCEPTION OF NEGATIVE IMPACTS OF GREYHOUND RACING




Q. And what would you say, if any are negative impacts of commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand? Base Total 2022 n=1,327, 2024 n=817

Only one in ten New Zealanders believe greyhounds bred for racing have a good life.

This has remained unchanged since 2022.

PERCEPTION THAT RACING GREYHOUNDS HAVE A GOOD LIFE




Q. Do you think greyhounds bred for racing have a good life? Base Total 2022 n=1,327, 2024 n=817

Half of the population think that gambling in general is acceptable. However, this falls to 18% when we talk about betting on greyhound racing.


Since 2022, we see a slight softening in the perceived acceptability of gambling on greyhound racing.

ACCEPTABILITY OF GAMBLING IN GENERAL





ACCEPTABILITY OF BETTING ON GREYHOUND RACING




Q. Do you think betting on greyhound racing is an acceptable form of entertainment?

Over the past 2 years, awareness that greyhound racing has been put "on notice" has increased significantly, with over a third of New Zealanders (38%) now aware.


SUPPORT FOR A BAN ON COMMERCIAL GREYHOUND RACING


The majority of New Zealanders (60%) would support a ban on commercial greyhound racing, and half of New Zealanders (51%) would be willing to sign a petition.

Only 8% would not support a ban.

Support for a ban on commercial greyhound racing is high across a broad range of demographic segments in New Zealand.

Even among the proportion of New Zealanders who have been to or bet on a greyhound race, over a third would support it being banned.






Q. Would you support a ban on commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand?

Over half of New Zealanders would support a ban on commercial greyhound racing with a transition period.

Over a third of New Zealanders are unsure, but we have seen that the vast majority do not think there are positives to commercial greyhound racing and support for its continuation is low.

Support for different options




- Q. Would you support a ban on commercial greyhound racing in New Zealand?


There is overwhelming preference for banning commercial greyhound racing, ether immediately (11%), or with a transition period (47%) to allow the rehoming of dogs currently involved in the industry.

LIKELY VOTING BEHAVIOUR IN REFERENDUM




Q. If a referendum was held tomorrow to ban commercial greyhound racing how would you vote?

Across New Zealand regions and age groups, the majority of New Zealanders would view to ban commercial greyhound racing in a referendum.

Support for banning is also high among those who have been to or bet on a greyhound race.

LIKELY VOTING BEHAVIOUR IN REFERENDUM %vote to ban commercial greyhound racing




Q. If a referendum was held tomorrow to ban commercial greyhound racing how would you vote? Base 2024 n=817

The majority of New Zealanders (66%) agree banning commercial greyhound racing is the right thing to do (68% in 2022).


57% of New Zealanders would be disappointed if the government did not ban commercial greyhound racing if given the opportunity (58% in 2022).
